The Étoile Santé campaign is an initiative of the PEI French Health Network, and its purpose is to promote, recruit and make people aware of health professionals who offer French language services in Prince Edward Island. From March 2 to March 22, 2017, anyone who nominated a health professional was entered to win \$500.
