

4. **Strategic plan**

Karen Langevin informed members that during the past two weeks, the French Language Health Services Coordinators met a number of times to do a SWOT analysis (strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, threats). This analysis can be found in section 6 of the Strategic plan.

Karen Langevin outlined the Strategic plan, one section at a time. Sections where changes were required are:

Section 2.1, paragraph 2 :

Karen Langevin informed members that in this section, the sentence: “Les services de langue française dans le système de la santé et des services sociaux seront de qualité comparable à ceux offerts en anglais dans les cinq communautés acadiennes et francophones de l’Î.-P.-É.” will be replaced by “Les services de langue française dans le système de la santé et des services sociaux seront de qualité comparable à ceux offerts en anglais à tous les résidents francophones de l’Î.-P.-É.” (French language services offered to all PEI Francophones in terms of health and social services will be of comparable quality to services offered in English.)

Section 5.2.1

Sylvie Plourde Farrell suggested changing the community names to: West Prince, Evangeline, Summerside, Charlottetown, Gulf Shore and Eastern Kings.

Section 5.3.1 e)

Sylvie Plourde Farrell asked that a confirmation be received from the French Language School Board in regards to the first year that English is taught to students.

Section 6.1.2

Section 6.3.1 c) i

A suggestion was made to add the word “Université” in front of “Laval” and to add “au Québec” after “Laval”.

The word “on-line” should be changed to “par vidéoconférence”.
